ABOUT

The average age of Kiwanis members is 64. Next year it will be 65. Kiwanis is getting older and now it is time to rejuvenate! Previous editions of the European Young Kiwanis Summit were successful, so we are coming back with a new edition in 2025 in Lisbon, Portugal!

AIM

The goal of this summit is to hear our younger members, to explore how they see the future of Kiwanis and how they plan to ensure succession and a bright future for our organization.

OBJECTIVES

- To give Young Kiwanians a forum to share how they see rejuvenation in the organisation
- To give Young Kiwanians a space to propose new initiatives for rejuvenation
- To give Young Kiwanians the opportunity to get on stage and take responsibility
- To engage and recruit young volunteers who can take responsibility at district & European levels
- To promote "younger" approaches to Kiwanis membership (new types of clubs, MeetUps,...)
- To brainstorm on new ideas about how we can grow with younger people.

ACCOMMODATION

Your hotel accommodation will be arranged. A single room with buffet breakfast included for the nights of Friday 2 May and Saturday 3 May 2025, will be booked and covered by organisation.

If you wish to extend your stay in Lisbon or arrive a day earlier to enjoy some extra tourist activities, you can arrange extra nights on your own wherever you'd like to stay.

MEALS

We cover a dinner on Friday evening at the hotel. Breakfast and lunch on Saturday at the hotel. On Saturday evening, we will go to another place, where we will start with finger food and a drink with the group. Then, each person can enjoy the famous and trendy food hall nearby.

Sunday we cover a breakfast at the hotel, and we end around 11:30am local time.

TRAVELS

All confirmed participants in the EYKS, are expected to be at the hotel around 17:30 local time and to arrange for their departure, bearing in mind that we will close the event at 11:30 on Sunday. You are arranging your own travel to the venue, and back home. All participants who get the confirmation that they are registered, will need to book their own flight.

Don't book your flight until you have received confirmation that you are enrolled!!

Confirmed participants arrange their own travel to the airport in their own country, book their own flights to and from Lisbon International airport, and take a direct metro from the airport to the venue.

We will provide more details about the travel, how to issue a metro ticket and so on. It's super-easy!

REIMBURSEMENTS



People who fully participate in the programme will be reimbursed for their travel costs, depending on the distance from their home to Lisbon, according to the official distance calculator of the European Commission: <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>

- If the distance from your home town/city to Lisbon is **LESS than 2000 kilometres**, with this distance calculator, we will reimburse you **up to 375 euros** for your travel. Any additional expenses for getting to the venue and returning home are your personal financial responsibility for the weekend.
- If the distance from your home town/city to Lisbon is **MORE than 2000 kilometers**, with this distance calculator, we will reimburse you **up to 500 euros** for your travel. Everything you spend more to get to the venue and back home, is your own contribution to the weekend.

We will provide you with a cost note during the European Young Kiwanis Summit.
